- Mission. To safeguard reenforcements during our advance in order to ensure their safe and timely arrival. Information. Enemy plane sighted us South of SATAWAN ISLAND six January zero seven hundred. Our submarines report a detachment of enemy battle cruisers, eight CAs, five CLs, about seventeen destroyers, transiting SAN BERNARDINO STRAITS at seventeen hundred six January standing Eastward. Assumptions. Assume above detachment will attack us, probably during daylight, by first concentrating all of his forces on our escort and then on the convoy. That he will endeavor to take advantage of the superior gun range of his battle line.
- This force will destroy or drive off enemy attacking 2. forces by fighting defensively on interior lines near convoy, by keeping interposed between enemy and our convoy, by counter attacking at favorable opportunities, and by liberal use of smoke to offset enemy superior gun range, in order to safeguard the reenforcements.
- (a) Battle Line. Engage any enemy force within range prior to ranging enemy battle line, then engage enemy battle line.

(b) Light forces. Defend own battle line and convoy. Lay smoke screens to cover own forces as ordered by O.T.C. Attack enemy battle line if and then ordered by O.T.C.

(c) Aircraft. Deny enemy plane spot. Provide plane spot for own CAs. Keep own forces advised of enemy Deny enemy plane spot. Provide plane movement. Lay smoke curtains as ordered by O.T.C. (d) Submarines. Attack at all favorable opportunities. Targets in order of preference, enemy CCs, CAs, CLs. (e) Convoy. Defend convoy. Zigzag and use smoke at

Disperse and seek safety in flight if and discretion. when ordered by O.T.C.

(x) Surface combatant units maintain interior lines; keep interposed between enemy and convoy; avoid being drawn too far away from convoy. O.T.C. will order changes of course to draw enemy battle line over our submarines. Avoid interference with our offective fire by smoke.

- Mission. To destroy BLUE Reenforcements, in order prevent their reaching the PHILIPPINES prior to the To destroy BLUE Reenforcements, in order to capture of MANILA BAY. Information. Contained in Eastern Detachment Operation Order No. One. Assumptions. That our battle line outranges that of the enemy, and that our best range is twenty-six thousand yards.
  That the enemy battle line has a gunnery advantage at ranges under twenty-two thousand yards. That our three battle cruisers are generally superior to two BLUE battleships at moderate ranges. That our heavy cruisers are greatly superior to BLUE cruiser strength, and outrange BLUE battleships. That the enemy will endeavor to prevent our use of the long range advantage by employment of destroyer and aircraft smoke screens and denial to us of plane spot. That the enemy will endeavor to destroy or drive off attacking units or delay the attack in carrying out his primary mission of protecting the convoy. That if the escort is destroyed the convoy will seek safety by scattering.
- This force will destroy BLUE Reenforcements; by attacking BLUE battleships at favorable ranges and simultaneously attacking convoy by Convoy Attack Group from opposite direction, by using Light Forces to protect own battle line, and by attacking all available objectives with submarines.
- (a) Battle Line maintain gun range near twenty-six thousand yards; if BLUE battle line is reduced by diversion or damage, close range.


(b) Light Forces protect Battle Line. When directed

attack enemy battleships.

(c) Submarines attack all available objectives. Enemy

battle line is primary objective.

(d) Convoy Attack Group attack convoy from direction opposite to that of Battle Line. Time attack to co-incide with attack by own Battle Line. Engage at long ranges BLUE battleships interposed between convoy and Convoy Attack Group.



(x) Commander Eastern Detachment will direct the execution of this plan by signal and will inform the Commander Convoy Attack Group when he expects to bring enemy battleships under fire. Battle Line will seek approach from northwesterly direction.
Aircraft from Convoy Attack Group and Light Forces
protect Battle Line spotting planes. Pursuit Plan
will be designated by the Officer in Tactical Command as necessary.

- Train remain at PELEWS.
- Rendezvous AFIRM-PELEWS, BAKER-GUAM. Officer in Tactical Command in CC-Three. Use contributary plans annexed.
