1. Reference (a), Commander Blue Force, Train, Secret Operation Order No. 2-C-32, of 25 January 1932, orders this force to maintain a patrol day and night for the security of the Train. There is no information of enemy.
2. This force will maintain day and night patrols of the channels leading to the base anchorage at Ishaina Roads. Be prepared to render assistance to damaged Blue submarines and Aircraft.
3. (a) KEALAIKANIKI CHANNEL PATROL will maintain patrols in KEALAIKANIKI CHANNEL. Maintain station patrol on line KAMAIKI POINT to KUREIA BAY. Deny channel to enemy forces.
- (b) ANAU CHANNEL PATROL maintain station patrol between MAHI POINT and KAWA POINT. Deny channel to enemy forces.
- (c) ALALAKIKI CHANNEL PATROL maintain line ULE POINT to NUKURU POINT. Deny channel to enemy forces.
- (d) DUTY TUG anchor in vicinity of Train flagship. Be prepared to render tug service.
