COURAGE IN WAR.

After two years of inquiry the War Office Committee on Shell Shock has decided that the term "shell shock" is inaccurate and must be abandoned. It does not matter what terms the experts use—whether shell shock, hysteria, concussion, commotion, or mental breakdown. Every soldier knows the thing itself, and does not care what the doctors call it. A few men know no fear, a few men show the white feather in face of any danger. In between come the great majority of soldiers who know fear but are able to conquer their natural funk and do their duty. It is good that the question of how much normal human nerves will stand should be studied. The war proved conclusively of what splendid stuff Englishmen are made: when they gave way, not cowardice but definite medical symptoms caused the breakdown.
