

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

Subj: C³I/Battle Management Systems Conference

1. As you know, Captain Dick Martin, in conjunction with the SSG work in crisis management decision-making, has been working with DARPA and ONR to develop DARPA's Battle Management System application for their 5th-generation computer project. Both these efforts have pointed out that a conference on the subject would be useful both to help focus the effort and to put NWC in the forefront of the thinking on this rapidly developing subject. The technical community recognizes the lack of naval strategy considerations in their designs for future systems, and NAVELEX (Code 06T) would co-host. Staff members at NAVELEX and OP-94 have chopped the invitation letter and list of invitees. We would envision about 45 participants from government. Senior attendees whom you may wish to personally invite include Admiral Bobby Inman, USN (Ret.) and Dr. Richard Beal of the NSC staff. Dr. Beal is aware of the planned conference; Admiral Inman is not, but we would be pleased to initiate advance liaison if you desire. A list of all invitees is attached as enclosure (2).
